

BJ MacDonald, Michael Lawrence and **Kayce Hoani Vincent** enjoyed a podium finish at the 2018 Oceania Junior Championships.

MacDonald was most unfortunate losing the U15B title in five. It was the fact he was 2 games to love up that hurt the most! He ended up losing the 50 minute final 12-10, 11-8, 1-11, 14-16, 5-11. Great effort BJ!

Kayce Hoani Vincent suffered only one loss in the 5 player U11G round robin and that was to the champion Maja Maziuk from NSW 9-11, 3-11, 3-11.

Michael Lawrence played well to secure 3rd place in the 6 player U11B round robin.

2018 AJO Results





BJ MacDonald was the only NR player to stand on the podium with a 2nd place finish in the U15B. Once again he was runner up to his arch rival and #1 seed Greg Chan (WA). This time he lost in four. BJ got the first but after a tight second game it was all over: 11-8, 11-13, 6-11, 2-11.

#4 seed BJ won his semi final against #2 seed Oscar Curtis in five 4-11, 11-3, 13-11, 9-11, 11-5 (45m). Despite the match taking longer BJ matched his effort in the OJC where as the #3 seed he beat Curtis (again #2 seed) in that semi 11-13, 11-8, 11-6, 8-11, 11-6 (34m).

Michael Lawrence was unlucky not to finish in the Top 3. He played the winner of the OJC in the 3/4 play off. After losing the OJC 6-11, 3-11, 2-11 Michael improved his performance to take a game off the Kiwi #1. This time he lost 11-9, 6-11, 4-11, 4-11 (23m).

Hayley Hankinson won the special plate in the U17G. Hayley lost to the #1 Kiwi in the main draw. She played Georgia Lane from NSW in the 5/6 play off. She won in three 11-5, 12-10, 11-5.



2018 REDSTAR AWARDS

ORTHERN REGION



In an effort to recognise more NR juniors we have revised our system of performance recognition. From now on every placegetter (1-2-3) will be recognised. Each winner of an aged event will be listed in the Achievement category and every player who finishes second or third will be listed in the Encouragement category.

Once a player has won an event they will be elevated and listed in the Achievement category even if they finish runner up or third in other events. If players are equal they will be listed in alphabetical order.

Players receive 3 points for winning a qualifier, 6 points for winning a Queensland State title and 9 points for winning a National title (AJO & AJC). Players will receive 2 points for finishing runner up in a qualifier, 4 points for runner up in a State final and 6 points for runner up in a National final. Players will receive 1 point for finishing third in a qualifier, 2 points for third in a State final and 3 points for third in a National event. U19 Players will also receive 1 bonus point for each result because they cannot enter 2 events.

Even though the Ingham qualifier was played in October 2017 it is still a 2018 qualifier so the results from that event will contribute to the **2018 NR Player of the Year Award.** A 2019 qualifier played in 2018 will not be included.

The player who accumulates the most points will be declared the Player of the Year. There will be joint winners if 2 players finish on the same number of points. The aim of the points system is to automate the selection and player results determine the outcome. The system is also designed to encourage players to support all events in their quest to accumulate points.

If an event is combined eg U17 and U19 Combined then it will be analysed to ensure points are allocated to both U17 and U19. A direct match up of the best two players in an age group will determine the winner of that age group. Otherwise the highest finishing position in an age group will receive the maximum points. **To be awarded points there must be at least two players competing in an age group.**

A player can only enter up to 2 events so they can only be rewarded with 2 results. An U9 player who might win a combined event eg **U9**, **U11 and U13 Combined** can only be rewarded for the U13 victory and their own age group U9 providing there are two U9 players competing. If there is only one player in U9 they will earn points for U13 only. If there was one player in U9 and one in U11 they will still only be rewarded for their efforts in U13.
