Let's look at the girls. **Ella Burge** has been a dominant force for a number of years now and will be an U17 player in 2019. She won her first State Title in 2016 (U13) and then won back to back U15 titles in 2017 and 2018. Her main opposition is likely to be Kurstyn Mather in 2019. They are already having some tight tussles.

Mackenzie Sleep won the title in 2016 (her first) and stepped up to win the U17 title the following year. She began 2018 in sensational style winning the AJO but missed the 2018 QJC and AJC. Lets hope she is back in 2019!

Siobhan Stephenson won her first and only QJC title in 2015. **Taylor Jones** won her first State title in 2014 before winning 3 more titles in her junior career.

The boys has seen 2014 Champion **Nick Calvert** go on to win six State Junior titles in total and become the #1 junior player in Australia in 2018. These days Nick is on the Pro Tour and is currently ranked World #211.

Jarred McCoombes won in 2015 but didn't go on to win any more titles. **Wes Dyer** won in 2016 and then had to wait a year to win the U17 title in 2018. He now has to step up to U19 but has the potential to win another State title.

BJ MacDonald has been around for a long time and only now moves up into U17. He won his first State title in 2014 (U11) and had to wait until 2016 to win his second (U13). He then hit a growth spurt and dominated the 2017 U15 title. In 2018 he was looking to win back to back titles but finished runner up to Malta's **Kijan Sultana**. BJ has the potential to get back to the top and win the U17 title in 2019.

Sandgate's **Ben Murray** and **Madison Lyon** will be the hot favourites to win the 2019 Under 15 State titles.
