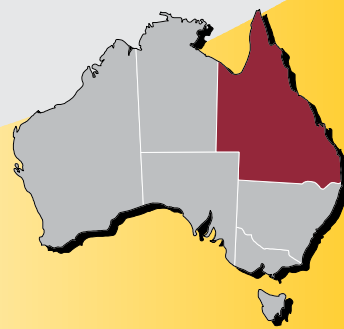

PSA COMMENTARY

Sandgate's **Jessica Turnbull** has just won her second PSA title beating #1 seed Sarah Cardwell in a 5 game 50 minute final.

Turnbull got off to a flying start winning the first 2 games but Cardwell steadied the ship and locked the match up at 2-2. However, it was all one way traffic in the 5th with Turnbull dominating and taking the 5th 11-2 to seal victory.

Turnbull won her first PSA title in Kalgoorlie in 2018. On that occasion she beat Cardwell in the semi final in five as well but had to fight back from 0-2 to ultimately win 8-11, 8-11, 11-6, 11-5, 11-9.

Turnbull and Cardwell look set to become a doubles combination at the upcoming World Doubles Championships on the Gold Coast in June.

Winning the U13 Queensland title informs the squash community you have arrived. You will be a force to be reckoned with in the ensuring years! In fact, it puts Australia on notice that you are one in particular that they need to be very wary of.

Many of our U13 Champions have gone on to win an Australian Junior Title.

Just in this short list of 10 players Queensland boasts 4 Aussie Champions.

Ethan Eyles won the U13 title in 2014 and the AJC in the same year. **Ben Murray** won the State title in 2017 before winning the U13 AJC title in 2018.

In 2015 **Hayley Hankinson** won the U13 QJC and AJC in the one year. She also went on to win the U15 Aussie title in 2016. **Madison Lyon** won the QJC AJC double in 2017.

Ethan Eyles won another QJC title in 2017 (U17) and **BJ MacDonald** went on to win the QJC U15 title in 2017.

Both Ethan Eyles and BJ MacDonald have already joined the PSA and are ranked 404 and 579 respectfully.

Ella Burge won in 2016 and went on to win two QJC titles in a row as an U15 player in 2017 and 2018. **Hayley Hankinson** won the U17 QJC title in 2018.

Keep an eye on U11 Champions Kayce Hoani Vincent (2017) and Orla Clarke (2018) to make their presence felt in the U13 Girls this year. In the boys U13 event Zane Wolpers (2017 U11 Champ) and Michael Lawrence (2018 U11 Champ) are expected to make bold showings.
