

Team Championship 5-7 July 2019


Despite winning three age groups to two Brisbane City couldn't roll the Northern Region Redbacks who were defending their Overall Team Championship crown.




A strong Sharks team has been put together to take back the Overall Team title they lost last year to Western Australia.






