#### Squash Queensland Board

Squash Queensland are gearing up for a big 2021 and the region representatives will have their first meeting in the coming weeks. On the agenda so far is Squash QLD AGM, Affiliations, Queensland Clubs, QJC Regional Teams, Direction for Schools Involvement in 2021 and beyond, Q Open and Club Teams Event, State Camps Scheduling and the Strategic Plan for 2021 and beyond.

Squash QLD are now enforcing, for all Squash QLD sanctioned tournaments, that a \$5/participant must be paid to Squash QLD. The NR Junior tournaments must all be Squash QLD and Squash Australia sanctioned tournaments to be approved ranking events. These funds will be used specifically to develop junior squash in QLD. The NR committee has decided this fee will need to be added to the tournament nomination fee as the current nomination fee could not absorb this new fee. This can be further discussed at the NR AGM in February.

Squash QLD are continuing to add to the value of affiliation. Currently, Colette is asking for anyone wanting to purchase Dunlop balls to get in touch with her to do a large group order through Squash QLD. For more details on this offer, including costs please contact Colette Sultana directly E: <u>info@squashqueensland.com.au</u>

If you have sponsors and partners who may wish to be recognised as Queensland partners please contact Colette to discuss this further. If you have current local sponsors please also contact Colette to discuss this so these deals work in everyone's favour.

If you are considering painting you squash court walls or your house, please contact Colette as Dulux are providing players and clubs with 30% discount on premium lines of paint (applicable to house paint and court paint requests) when purchases are made through the Squash QLD cash account.

Squash QLD are currently offering 8 grants to 8 Queensland centres (2 in each Region) to provide squash programs for 8-12 year olds (new players and beginners). Each grant is for \$625. The goal of these grants are to help grow the sport of squash and recruit some new young players. Application for these grants have closed. To my knowledge Mackay 52 and Cairns Squash have applied for this grant and we should hear from Squash QLD soon about these funds.

Please note Mackay and Cairns are the compulsory tournaments. To qualify for selection to the Redbacks team, juniors must play three (3) of the four (4) NR Junior tournaments. A junior must play both compulsory tournaments in Cairns and Mackay and at least 1 tournament in Ingham (TBC) or Townsville. Juniors who meet this criteria will be given priority consideration when the Redbacks are selected regardless of strength of an individual who has not fully qualified or strength of the overall team. Please do not assume you will be selected to the Northern Redbacks if you have not qualified by attending the required tournaments or have not provided medical evidence to remain eligible.

#### For 2021 Junior Season:

*Compulsory tournaments (Mackay and Cairns) will be age and gender format. Non-Compulsory tournaments (Ingham and Townsville) will be divisions.*

#### 2021 QUEENSLAND JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

The QJC to be held in Cairns in June/July 2021. The Queensland Squash Administrator will manage the QJC. The functions the administrator will manage are the setup of SportyHQ, setting the seedings according to the QLD seedings list, setting the draws, match scheduling and being at the championships to run the individual and team events.

Squash QLD, NR and Cairns Squash are coordinating to make this event successful and memorable. There is lots to be done and we welcome everyone to get involved. Contact me if you have any ideas or you can offer your time to help. In particular we are seeking sponsors and people to help with social media.

#### **QLD JUNIOR RANKINGS**

Since January 2020, the QLD Junior rankings have been updated by the Squash Queensland Administrator. So far this is working very well and reducing the burden on the NR to apply the actual ranking policy after junior tournaments.

1 Dec 2020 Queensland Junior rankings are available on the Squash Queensland Webpage.

The State junior rankings and associated combined seedings will be relied upon by the Northern Region tournament hosts to set draws. Timely appeals will be essential. The appeal process in the policy provides for an internal review (like the old policy to give the rankers a chance to affirm or change their mind), and if the appellant remains aggrieved by that review decision, the appeal must be decided by an independent decision maker.

#### **AFFILIATION WITH Q SQUASH**

If you were not affiliated in 2020, now is the time to affiliate for 2021. If you were affiliated in 2020, your affiliation is good until March as Squash Queensland have extended the affiliation period due to Covid shutdowns in 2020.

Affiliation is compulsory for all juniors to compete in the NR Junior tournaments and in the State and National Championships. Juniors must have full affiliation to play for the Northern Redbacks. Affiliation status will be checked prior to all 2021 season NR Junior tournaments and the Queensland Junior Championships.

Affiliation fees: \$73 for a full 1 year; or \$44 for seasonal (6 months). Please remember affiliation comes with all sorts of benefits – especially personal insurance

with participating in the game or related activity, such as fundraising.

Please note players living in Mackay, Townsville, Ingham and Cairns and all areas in between along the coast are not considered remote and do not qualify for the Remote Member Registration.

Due to the Covid-19 restrictions Queensland Squash has extended the 2020 affiliation periods.

#### NORTHERN REGION MEETING

The next NR meeting will be at the 2021 Smithfield Dental Cairns Junior Championships in Feb 2021. This will also be the AGM.

Standing items on the agenda are coaching clinics, regional participation, grants, 2021 QJC. Additional item is Bi-Laws and the NR Junior Tournament nomination fees.

After a great deal of consideration I have decided I will not stand for re-election at the 2021 AGM. I urge everyone to please consider taking up a position on the committee. If you need further information please contact myself or another member of the current committee.

#### **FUNDING/GRANTS**

Unfortunately, the NR were not successful to win the Australian Sports Foundation grant for \$5,400 to fund 2021 Redback Player's uniforms.

Cairns Squash also was not successful to win the Australian Sports Foundation grant for \$7,000 to purchase training shirts for the juniors and new training equipment.

Cairns Squash are in the process of designing grandstands and installing IT equipment with a grant from the Active Restart Infrastructure Recovery Fund worth \$15,500 and a grant worth \$35,000 from the Queensland Gambling Community Fund.

Cairns Squash was successful to gain funds from the Covid-19 grants to support clubs to get back on the court. Cairns is using some of these funds to subsidise the new Club shirts.

Grant money is really free money available to all clubs if you are willing to spend some time seeking suitable grants and completing the applications. Organisation applications vary in

complexity. However, most applications are relatively simple and do not take too much time to complete. All centres should be applying for grants. Please consider how you can help your club and if you have any ideas or you can help with identifying grants and writing applications please contact Karlye Rhodes E: <u>doug.rhodes@bigpond.com for assistance.</u>

Currently Squash Australia are also offering all squash clubs the opportunity to have support to apply for grants. For more information E: facilities@squash.org.au or go to https://www.squash.org.au/w/membership/facility-grant-writers.

Cash for Cans is a great fundraising idea for clubs. The Bunnings Sausage Sizzle days are back on with very strict Covid-19 restrictions but I'm sure they will be a very fruitful fundraising activity once again.

Please consider getting a group together to fundraise for your club.

#### **SPORTY HQ**

Squash Australia (SA) has advised SA will cover subscription cost for affiliated clubs. Please do not pay for any SportyHQ subscriptions prior to discussing your clubs status and encourage all your club members to pay their affiliations to take advantage of this.

Squash Queensland have announced they are currently trialling Club Locker which is an internet based program that provides similar functions to SportyHQ. This trial is to understand which system, Club Locker or SportyHQ is the more suited to everyone's needs.

### **Nomination fees** for the 2021 NR Junior Qualifiers:

Age event \$50 for one event or \$65 for 2 events Graded (Novice) \$20 per player Doubles \$10 per player

At each NR junior tournament a portion of the nomination fees is paid to the NR for the purpose of subsidising coaches to attend the QJC. \$10 (Age) and \$5 (Graded) is collected from each player.

From 1/1/21 all NR Junior Qualifiers must now be sanctioned by **Squash Queensland.** Accordingly a \$5 Fee is collected and paid to Squash Queensland.

- Encourage and support clubs and court owners to apply for grants.
- Encourage progression of squash with increased use of technology to increase public appeal and participation.
- Be a signatory at the bank.

### **VICE PRESIDENT'S ROLE:**

- Be available to NR Members, parents, coaches, club committee member and court owners.
- Work with Clubs to arrange and manage the NR junior tournaments.
- Advise SQ and Squash Australia of the NR junior tournament dates.
- Consider gaps and barriers to participation and introduce new ideas support promotion and growth of squash.
- Work with Squash Media to promote the NR junior tournaments.
- Support clubs to use SportyHQ and liaise with SportyHQ developers as required.
- Follow up and write grant applications and drive fundraising opportunities.
- Encourage and support clubs and court owners to apply for grants.
- Work with clubs and NR members to contribute content to the NR newsletter.
- Manage the NR social media facebook and webpage.
- Yearly review of the QJC player, coaches, parents, and manager's paperwork for QJC.
- Encourage progression of squash with increased use of technology to increase public appeal and participation.
- Be a signatory at the bank.

## **TREASURER'S ROLE:**

- Set budgets, mostly for the QJC and grant money.
- Have an understanding of GST and basic accounting functions.
- Create and send out QJC invoices.
- Send reminders for overdue accounts.
- Send receipts for money received.
- Make reimbursements as required and appropriate.
- Advise the President of any financial concerns.
- Reconcile accounts as invoices are paid.
- Pay bills.
- Manage the bank accounts.
- Prepare accounts for the auditor.
- Ensure appropriate spending of grant funding and sponsorship money, maintain appropriate receipts and complete the acquittal process.
- Be a signatory at the bank.

## **NR SELECTOR'S ROLE:**

#### 3 Positions

- Must be available to travel to the NR junior tournaments.
- Must have an interest to track progression of juniors for consideration of selection to the Northern Redbacks.
- Must be available for discussion with other selectors and the NR Committee about the Northern Redback's team selection and team captains.
- Be aware of the ranking policy and NR junior's rankings.
- Must avoid favouritism for own players and children when selecting the Northern Redback's representatives. Selection must be based on merit/performance.

Note: NR selectors will no longer be required to update the Junior rankings.





## 2020-21 State Affiliation

### IMPORTANT UPDATE from Squash Queensland: Player Affiliation Fees for 2020/21

Due to COVID-19 forced closures this year players have missed out on several weeks of their affiliation playing benefits and so the Board has decided to roll over this year's affiliations into next year. Whether you have already paid affiliation this year or have still to pay for it, the following changes apply:

1. The 2020 12 month player affiliation now expires on March 10th 2021, instead of the original 31st Dec 2020 expiry date.



2. The 2020 (Jan - June) 6 month affiliation plan now expires on 10th Sep 2020, instead of the original 30th June 2020 expiry.

3. The second 6 months of the 2020 year (Jul - Dec) will be due on 10th Sep 2020 and will expire on 10th March 2021.

4. Seasonal affiliation fees are still being discussed and will depend on the fixtures season in your region. More to come on that in the next few weeks.

5. We have introduced a remote player affiliation option, this is a discounted affiliation option for players who play at a location that is at least 300kms from the Eastern Sea Board. We hope that this encourages players from remote areas in QLD to also affiliate and be covered by player insurance.

6. A monthly affiliation option is also available (at \$10 per month excl. GST)
